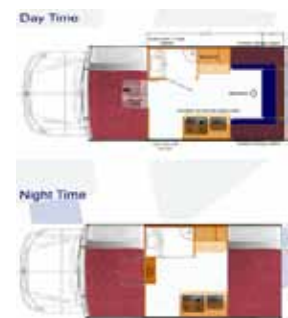
Easy to use, hop in and go
